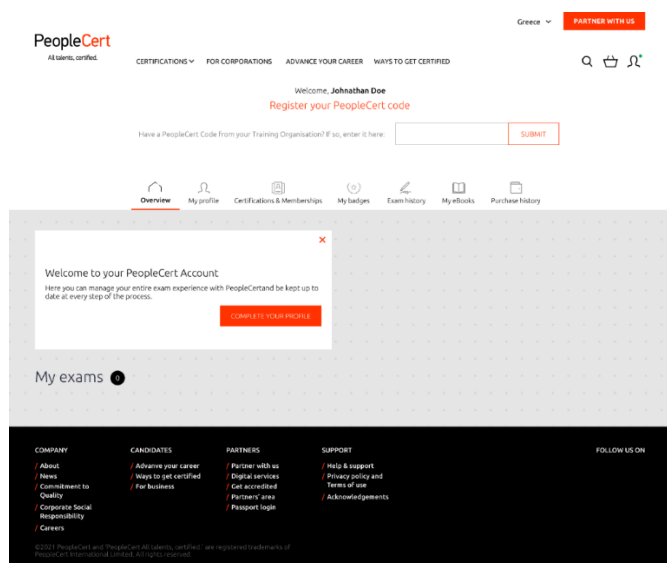

Candidate's Journey:

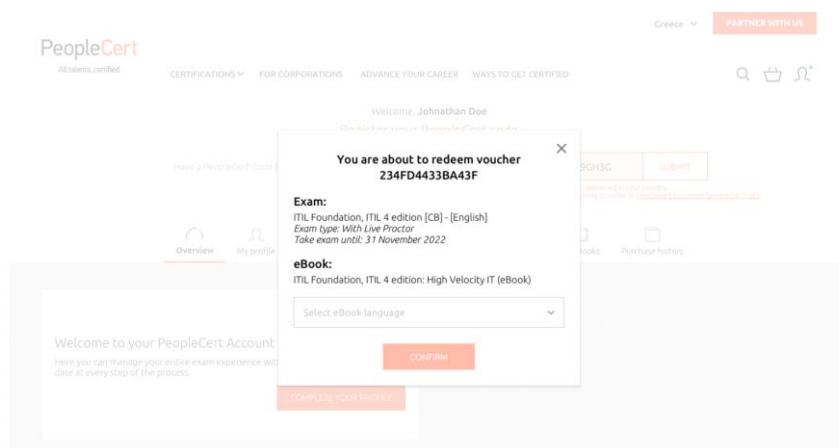
Redeem an exam and eBook voucher and gain access to your eBook

STEP 1

As soon as the candidate logs into their **PeopleCert Account** they will be presented with their **Welcome Screen**. In this screen, the candidate will have the option to navigate amongst several options but importantly, they will be able to **redeem the voucher they received from the partner by filling in the voucher code in the respective field**.



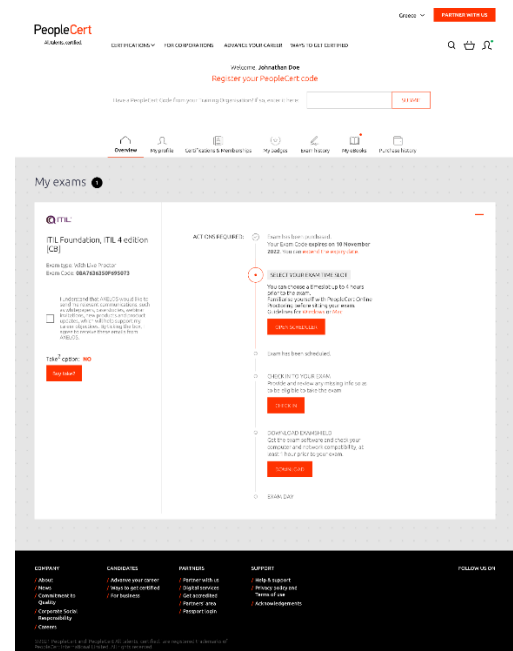
STEP 2



As soon as a Voucher is submitted, a **confirmation screen** will appear, verifying the action and **asking the candidates to choose the language of preference** for the ebook about to be purchased (if the test centre has not already pre-selected it during voucher order).

STEP 3

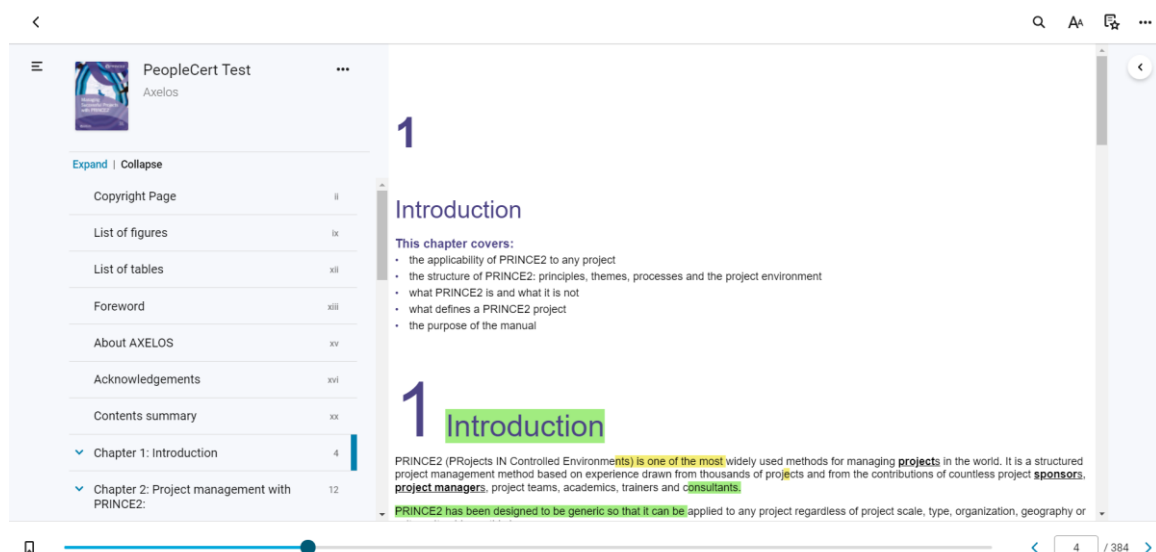
Upon **completion of the 'redeem process'**, the candidates are presented with a new screen with a notification red dot that will show that there is a **new eBook available** for them in their library. On this page, the candidates will have the option to proceed with scheduling their exam upon convenience.



STEP 4

In the **new My eBooks tab** the candidates are one click away from accessing their eBook in the PeopleCert branded VitalSource library for Online or Offline reading, notetaking, highlighting and many more functionalities in 37 languages, that support an effective learning experience.

1 Introduction

PRINCE2 (PRINCE2 IN Controlled Environments) is one of the most widely used methods for managing projects in the world. It is a structured project management method based on experience drawn from thousands of projects and from the contributions of countless project sponsors, project managers, project teams, academics, trainers and consultants.

PRINCE2 has been designed to be generic so that it can be applied to any project regardless of project scale, type, organization, geography or culture. It achieves this by:

- separating the management of project work from the specialist contributions, such as design or construction. The specialist aspects of any type of project are easily integrated with the PRINCE2 method and, used alongside PRINCE2, provide a secure overall framework for the project work
- focusing on describing what needs to be done, rather than prescribing how everything is done.

PRINCE2:

- is based on established and proven best practice and governance for project management
- can be tailored to meet the specific needs of the organization and scaled to the size and complexity of different projects

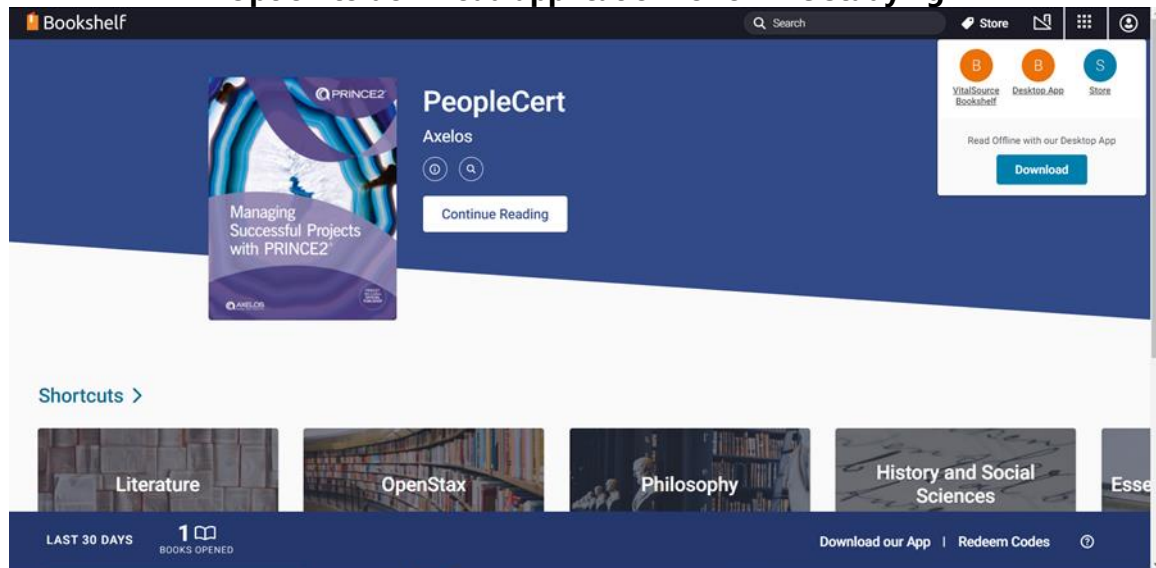
