What is Agile? Why be Agile in your projects?

Based on the proven DSDM Agile Project Framework (AgilePF), the Agile Business Analyst (AgileBA) is crucial to the success and competitiveness of organisations in the rapidlychanging environment working in an Agile way. The Business Analyst is a critical role within an Agile project team. The AgileBA gives context to the BA role beyond the individual project, in relation to organisational processes, mission and strategy.

AgileBA certification and qualification has been developed by the Agile Business Consortium, and training and examinations are offered through the global awarding body APMG International..

This course covers the certification examinations for Foundation and Practitioner.

PRE-REQUISITES

There is no pre-requisite for the course. However, some experience and awareness in project work as well as product or software development would be advantageous.

CERTIFICATION EXAMS

The AgileBA Foundation examination will lead to Foundation certification. The format of the examination is:

- ▲ 50 scored multiple choice questions
- ▲ Duration of 40 minutes
- ▲ 25 marks (50%) required to pass
- Closed book examination
- No negative marking for incorrect answers.

The AgileBA Practitioner examination will lead to Practitioner certification. The format of the examination is:

- 80 scored complex multiple choice (part) questions
- Duration of 2 hours 30 minutes (including reading time)
- ▲ 40 marks (50%) required to pass
- Open book examination (only AgileBA Handbook is allowed)
- No negative marking for incorrect answers.

Passing the AgileBA Foundation exam is a pre-requisite for taking the Practitioner exam.
